Payment Options for Cash Businesses.

Texas - RBFCU

Non-members cannot directly deposit cash into an RBFCU account because RBFCU's policy requires the transacting person to be identified for all transactions, and RBFCU doesn't facilitate cash deposits for non-members.

1. Obtain a money order

Buy a money order or a cashier's check from a bank and then present that to the member, who can then deposit the item into their RBFCU account.

2. Use an electronic or wire transfer:

If the non-member has an account at another bank, they can send the funds electronically to the member's RBFCU account. A non-member can send a wire transfer from their bank to the RBFCU account.

Ohio - 717 Credit Union

Non-members can directly deposit cash into a 717 Credit Union account using option #3.

1. Obtain a money order:

Buy a money order or a cashier's check from bank and then present that to the member, who can then deposit the item into their 717 Credit Union account.

2. Use an electronic or wire transfer:

If the non-member has an account at another bank, they can send the funds electronically to the member's 717 Credit Union account. A non-member can send a wire transfer from their bank to the 717 Credit Union account.

3. Use Personal Teller Machines

You will need:

An ID, IDs will be scanned at the PTM for all non-members depositing on a member's behalf. A phone number to reach you, if there is a problem.

The business name and the business account number.

What to Do:

Use Personal Teller Machines at a branch location.

Use the touch screen to the left to begin speaking to a live Personal Teller.

Follow the Personal Teller instructions to deposit the cash into the PTM.

The Personal Teller will confirm.

The PTM will give you a deposit receipt.

Don't forget to retrieve your ID.
